NOTE

During the installation, the software will test the connection with the NDD Print Data Center, which will be performed through the HTTPS Protocol (Port 443). In some cases, it will be necessary to configure the Proxy to allow the connection. When required, the installer will pop-up a message, then you need to click 'Accept' to start the Proxy setup assistant.

This module allows to use a SQL Server Database to improve performance, recommended when the environment has more than 200 printers.



NDD Print Agent is installed with NDD Print 360 Releaser.

If the NDD Print 360 Releaser is installed on another server than the NDD Print Host, you will be prompted for the Server Address at installation time. For more information about other installation methods, check the manual.
